## Beelicious Purple Hyssop



### Beelicious® Purple Hyssop

#### Description:

An easy-to-care for, upright and well branched selection featuring spikes of vibrant purple flowers with rose calyces; a favorite for native butterflies and hummingbirds; soothing, aromatic, licorice scented foliage for the fragrant garden

#### Ornamental Features

Beelicious Purple Hyssop features airy spikes of lightly-scented purple tubular flowers with rose calyces rising above the foliage from mid summer to early fall, which emerge from distinctive pink flower buds. The flowers are excellent for cutting. Its attractive fragrant pointy leaves remain grayish green in colour with distinctive dark green veins throughout the season.

#### Landscape Attributes

Beelicious Purple Hyssop is an open herbaceous annual with an upright spreading habit of growth. Its relatively fine texture sets it apart from other garden plants with less refined foliage.

This is a relatively low maintenance plant, and is best cleaned up in early spring before it resumes active growth for the season. It is a good choice for attracting bees, butterflies and hummingbirds to your yard, but is not particularly attractive to deer who tend to leave it alone in favor of tastier treats. It has no significant negative characteristics.

Beelicious Purple Hyssop is recommended for the following landscape applications;

### Planting & Growing

Beelicious Purple Hyssop will grow to be about 12 inches tall at maturity extending to 16 inches tall with the flowers, with a spread of 12 inches. Although it's not a true annual, this fast-growing plant can be expected to behave as an annual in our climate if left outdoors over the winter, usually needing replacement the following year. As such, gardeners should take into consideration that it will perform differently than it would in its native habitat.

This plant should only be grown in full sunlight. It prefers dry to average moisture levels with very well-drained soil, and will often die in standing water. It is considered to be drought-tolerant, and thus makes an ideal choice for a low-water garden or xeriscape application. It is not particular as to soil type, but has a definite preference for alkaline soils, and is able to handle environmental salt. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. This particular variety is an interspecific hybrid. It can be propagated by division; however, as a cultivated variety, be aware that it may be subject to certain restrictions or prohibitions on propagation.

Beelicious Purple Hyssop is a fine choice for the garden, but it is also a good selection for planting in outdoor pots and containers. It is often used as a 'filler' in the 'spiller-thriller-filler' container combination, providing a mass of flowers and foliage against which the larger thriller plants stand out. Note that when growing plants in outdoor containers and baskets, they may require more frequent waterings than they would in the yard or garden.
