### Description:

This fast growing, vigorous climber bears an abundance of single, pale yellow blooms throughout the season; delicately fragrant; a stunning addition to trellises, arbors or trained on houses; repeat bloomer from spring to fall

### Ornamental Features

Mermaid Climbing Rose features showy clusters of lightly-scented buttery yellow flowers along the branches from late spring to early fall. The flowers are excellent for cutting. It has dark green deciduous foliage. The glossy oval compound leaves do not develop any appreciable fall colour.

### Landscape Attributes

Mermaid Climbing Rose is a multi-stemmed deciduous woody vine with a twining and trailing habit of growth. Its average texture blends into the landscape, but can be balanced by one or two finer or coarser trees or shrubs for an effective composition.

This is a high maintenance woody vine that will require regular care and upkeep, and is best pruned in late winter once the threat of extreme cold has passed. It is a good choice for attracting bees to your yard. It has no significant negative characteristics.

Mermaid Climbing Rose is recommended for the following landscape applications;

- Mass Planting
- Hedges/Screening
- General Garden Use

### Planting & Growing

Mermaid Climbing Rose will grow to be about 25 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 15 feet. As a climbing rose, it can be leggy near the base and may be concealed by underplanting with lower-growing facer plants. It should be planted near a fence, trellis or other landscape structure where it can be trained to grow upwards on it, or allowed to trail off a retaining wall or slope. It grows at a fast rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 30 years.

This woody vine does best in full sun to partial shade. It does best in average to evenly moist conditions, but will not tolerate standing water. To help this plant achieve its best flowering performance, periodically apply a flower-boosting fertilizer from early spring through into the active growing season. It is not particular as to soil type or pH. It is highly tolerant of urban pollution and will even thrive in inner city environments. This particular variety is an interspecific hybrid.
