Description:

The brightness of the perfectly shaped flowers attracts the eye with its deep scarlet red blooms standing tall above the deep green foliage; perfect for cutting, the strong raspberry fragrance will last for days; excellent disease resistance

Ornamental Features

Love's Promise Rose features showy fragrant scarlet flowers at the ends of the branches from early summer to mid fall. The flowers are excellent for cutting. It has dark green deciduous foliage. The oval compound leaves do not develop any appreciable fall color.

Landscape Attributes

Love's Promise Rose is a multi-stemmed deciduous shrub with an upright spreading habit of growth. Its average texture blends into the landscape, but can be balanced by one or two finer or coarser trees or shrubs for an effective composition.

This shrub will require occasional maintenance and upkeep, and is best pruned in late winter once the threat of extreme cold has passed. It is a good choice for attracting bees to your yard. It has no significant negative characteristics.

Love's Promise Rose is recommended for the following landscape applications;

- Accent
- Mass Planting
- Hedges/Screening
- General Garden Use

Planting & Growing

Love's Promise Rose will grow to be about 5 feet tall at maturity, with a spread of 4 feet. It tends to fill out right to the ground and therefore doesn't necessarily require facer plants in front, and is suitable for planting under power lines. It grows at a fast rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 30 years.

It is highly tolerant of urban pollution and will even thrive in inner city environments. This particular variety is an interspecific hybrid.
